

Sewing the Pillows:

A seam allowance of $\frac{1}{4}$ inch is incorporated into the pattern.

There is a pivot at the bottom of the heart.

The hole for stuffing is about 3"

I find it is easiest to start on the righthand side about 1 and $\frac{1}{2}$ inches up from the point and continue right around to 3 inches above the starting point.

I found that by putting the flannel on top, the fabric did not creep and required fewer pins.

No clipping is required with the narrow seam allowance.

No ironing is required.

It is best to store the sewn pillows inside out to avoid creases developing along the seam and necessitating ironing.

Handstitching

I found it was best to sew up from the point to the top of the heart and then to readjust the stuffing when finished.
